**A BY-LAW TO AMEND TRAFFIC BY-LAW 78-2005
TO ESTABLISH COMMUNITY SAFETY ZONES
(Elizabeth– between Clara Street and Amelia Street
Clara Street between Elizabeth Street and Fead Street and
Amelia Street between Elizabeth Street and College Avenue)**

WHEREAS Section 214.1(1) of the *Highway Traffic Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.H.8, as amended, authorizes municipalities to pass by-laws to designate a part of a highway under its jurisdiction as a community safety zone;

AND WHEREAS on October 2, 2006, by resolution number ⁸*, Council directed that a by-law be presented to create further community safety zones;


NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF ORANGEVILLE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT Traffic By-law No. 78-2005, as amended, be further amended to add the following community safety zone to Schedule N::

COMMUNITY SAFETY ZONES

Highway	Between	Times
Elizabeth Street	Clara Street and Amelia Street	Any time
Clara Street	Elizabeth Street and Fead Street	Any time
Amelia Street	Elizabeth Street and College Avenue	Any time
