

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF ORANGEVILLE

BY-LAW NUMBER 88-93

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND ZONING BY-LAW NUMBER 22-90

WHEREAS THE Corporation of the Town of Orangeville has passed By-law 13-93 to zone certain lands Residential Fifth Density Holding [R5(H)], Residential Sixth Density Holding [R6(H)], Development (D), Open Space - Recreation (OS1), and Open Space - Conservation (OS2), for the Town of Orangeville

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Orangeville deems it expedient to enact this By-law to amend By-law 22-90, as amended by By-law 13-93, by removing the Holding (H) symbol on the R5(H) and R6(H) zones.

NOW THEREFORE THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF ORANGEVILLE BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL THEREOF ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Zoning By-law No. 22-90, as amended, is further amended by removing the holding symbol (H) from the Residential Fifth Density Holding [R5(H)] and Residential Sixth Density Holding [R6(H)] Zones on the lands described as Part of Lot 30, Concession 1, E.H.S., Town of Orangeville and shown on Schedule "A", attached to this By-law.
2. No person shall use any part of the lands as shown on Schedule "A" or erect, alter, or use any building or structure for any purpose on such land except those permitted in the Residential Fifth Density (R5) or the Residential Sixth Density (R6) zone of By-law 22-90, as amended.
3. This By-law shall take effect and come into force from the date of its passage by Council, in accordance with Subsections 34 and 36 of the Planning Act, R.S.O., 1990, Chapter P.13.

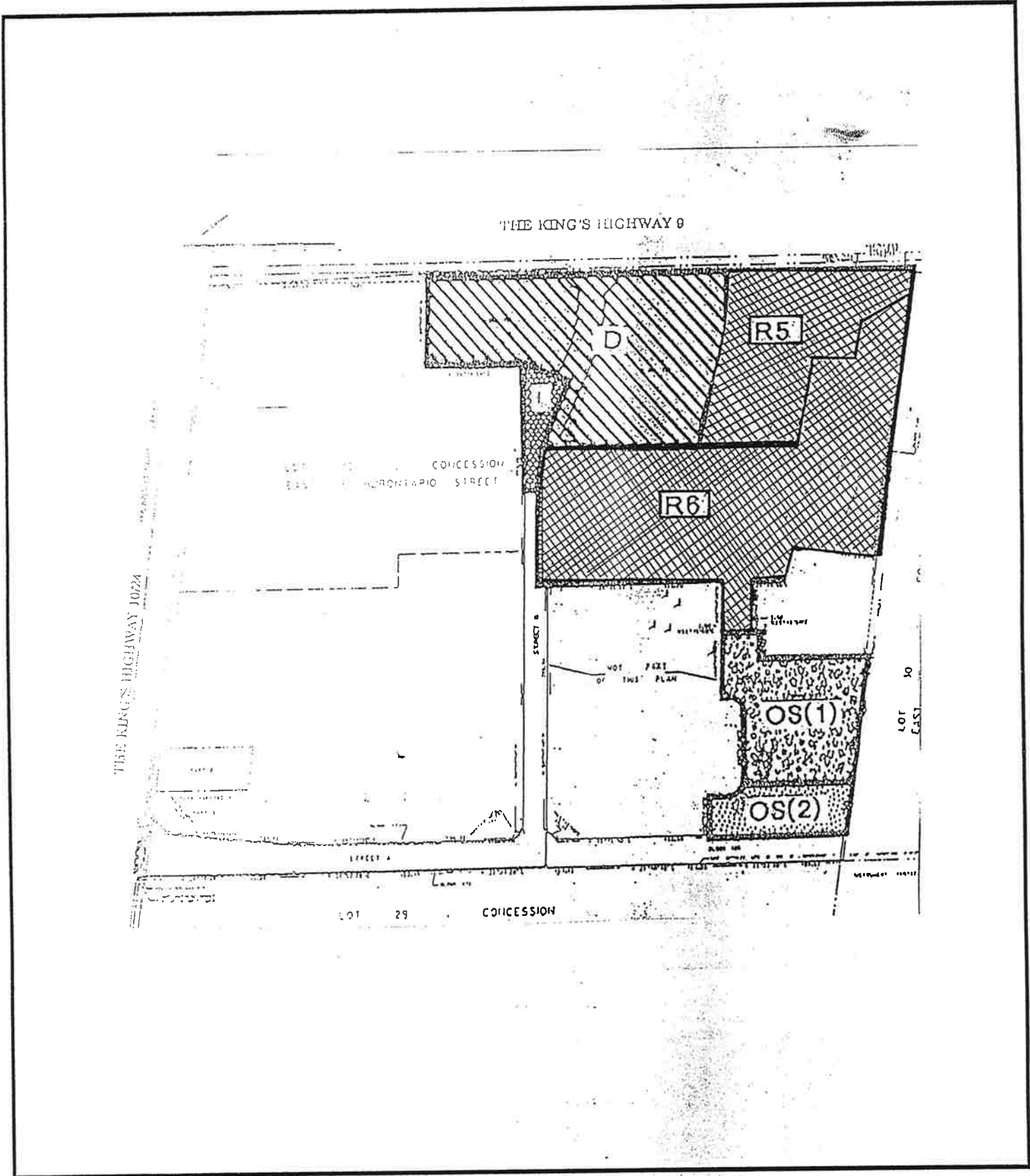
