BY-LAW NUMBER **016 - 2018**

**A BY-LAW TO AMEND TRAFFIC BY-LAW NO. 78-2005
TO WITH RESPECT TO ENFORCEMENT OF ELECTRIC VEHICLE
CHARGING STATIONS AND ELECTRIC VEHICLE PARKING SPACES**

WHEREAS Section 11 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, as amended, authorizes municipalities to pass by-laws prohibiting or regulating parking on highways and on properties other than highways;

And whereas Council deems it expedient to amend By-law No. 78-2005, as amended;

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF ORANGEVILLE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the definitions listed in Section 1, be amended to include electric vehicles, electric vehicle charging station, and electric vehicle parking space.

DEFINITIONS

“electric vehicle” means a vehicle that is propelled by one or more electric motors.

“electric vehicle charging station” means a device that supplies electric current for the purpose of recharging electric vehicles.

“electric vehicle parking space” means a parking space for the exclusive use of electric vehicles while plugged into an electric vehicle charging station.


2. That Section 4.3. be amended to include provisions to enforce the use of electric vehicle charging stations and electric vehicle parking spaces.

4.3 Parking at Municipally-Owned or Controlled Facilities/Property


4.3.2 Where signs are erected and on display, no person shall park or leave any motor vehicle on municipally-owned or controlled property for a period in excess of twenty-four (24) hours.

- 4.3.7 Notwithstanding Section 4.3.2 of this By-law, no person shall park a non-electric vehicle within a designated electric vehicle parking space.
- 4.3.8 Notwithstanding Section 4.3.2. of this By-law, no person shall park a vehicle or electric vehicle not being actively connected to an electric vehicle charging station.
