### By-law Number 2020-019

#### A by-law to amend By-law 31-2003 being a By-law to regulate the display of merchandise on sidewalks

Whereas Council passed By-law 31-2003 on 17<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2003 to regulate the display of merchandise on sidewalks;

And Whereas Council at its meeting held on 9<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2020 passed Resolution 2020-077 to permit benches or café tables and chairs as part of a business façade merchandise display in accordance with the current width and walking area requirements;


Now therefore be it resolved that Council of the Corporation of the Town of Orangeville hereby enacts as follows:

1. That By-law 31-2003 be amended by deleting the definition of “merchandise” and replacing it with the following definition:

“merchandise” means goods or wares customarily sold by the retail establishment and includes benches, café tables and chairs and other items associated with the promotion of the retail establishment but does not include signs, signage, heaters, lights, hazardous or flammable materials such as gasoline, oil, antifreeze, kerosene, poisons, pesticides and similar items.

Read three times and finally passed by Council this 6<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2020.
