

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF ORANGEVILLE

BY-LAW NUMBER 5-98

A by-law to amend By-law 22-90, as amended (Orangeville Agricultural Society, Part 1, 7R-3749, 76 Fifth Avenue, Z 12/97).

WHEREAS THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF ORANGEVILLE DEEMS IT APPROPRIATE TO ENACT THIS BY-LAW,

NOW THEREFORE THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF ORANGEVILLE BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL THEREOF ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT Zoning Maps A4 and B4 of Schedule "A" to By-law 22-90, as amended, is hereby amended in accordance with Schedule "A" hereto.

2. THAT Section 24.83 of By-law 22-90, as amended, is hereby amended by amending the opening clause to read as follows:

"Notwithstanding the provisions of the General Commercial (C1) Zone and the Open Space Recreation (OS1) Zone, the following provisions shall apply to the lands show on Schedule "A" as C1 (H<sub>1</sub>H<sub>2</sub>) S.P. 24.83 and OS1 S.P. 24.83:"

3. THAT Section 24.83 of By-law 22-90, as amended, is hereby amended to add the following paragraphs thereto:

10) Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 5.17 of By-law 22-90, as amended, the minimum parking requirement for the existing curling arena shall be 71 parking spaces, to be provided within the area zoned OS1 and on adjoining lands zoned C1.

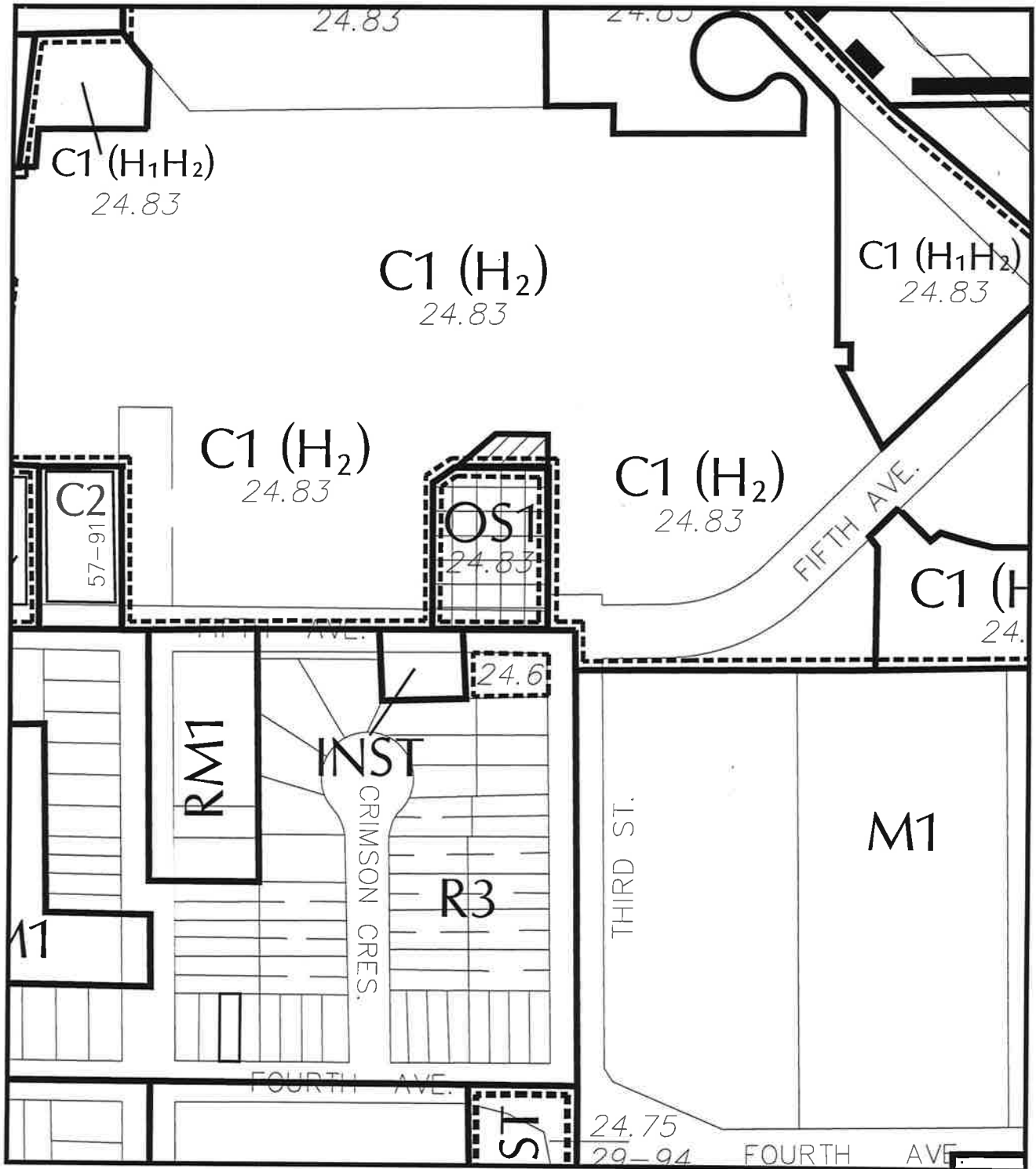
11) Notwithstanding the provisions of the Open Space Recreation (OS1) Zone, the minimum front yard of the existing curling arena is 3 metres.

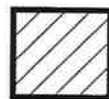
