

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF ORANGEVILLE

BY-LAW NO .11-67..

A BY-LAW TO PROHIBIT THE OBSTRUCTING,
ENCUMBERING, INJURING OR FOULING OF
HIGHWAYS OR BRIDGES

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF ORANGEVILLE
BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL THEREOF ENACTS AS
FOLLOWS:-

(1) The obstructing, encumbering, injuring or fouling of highways or bridges under the jurisdiction of The Corporation of the Town of Orangeville is hereby prohibited.

(2) Every person who contravenes this By-law is guilty of an offence punishable by the imposition of a fine not exceeding \$300.00, exclusive of costs, and such fine and costs shall be recoverable under the provisions of The Summary Convictions Act provided that in the event of non-payment of the said fine and costs, the offender shall be liable to a term of imprisonment for a period not exceeding 21 days.

This By-law shall come into force and take effect from and after the passing thereof.
