BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 22-90, AS AMENDED (Canaletto Investments Limited, 475 and 489 Broadway, H 4/05).

WHEREAS on March 6, 2006, Council approved Holding Removal Application H 4/05 to facilitate the construction of a 1,657 square metre commercial building anchored by a 1,578 square metre Shoppers Drug Mart store, the relocation and restoration of the Robert Perfect House and associated parking at 475 and 489 Broadway;

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of Orangeville as follows:

1. That Zoning Map B2 is hereby amended in accordance with Schedule "A" hereto.

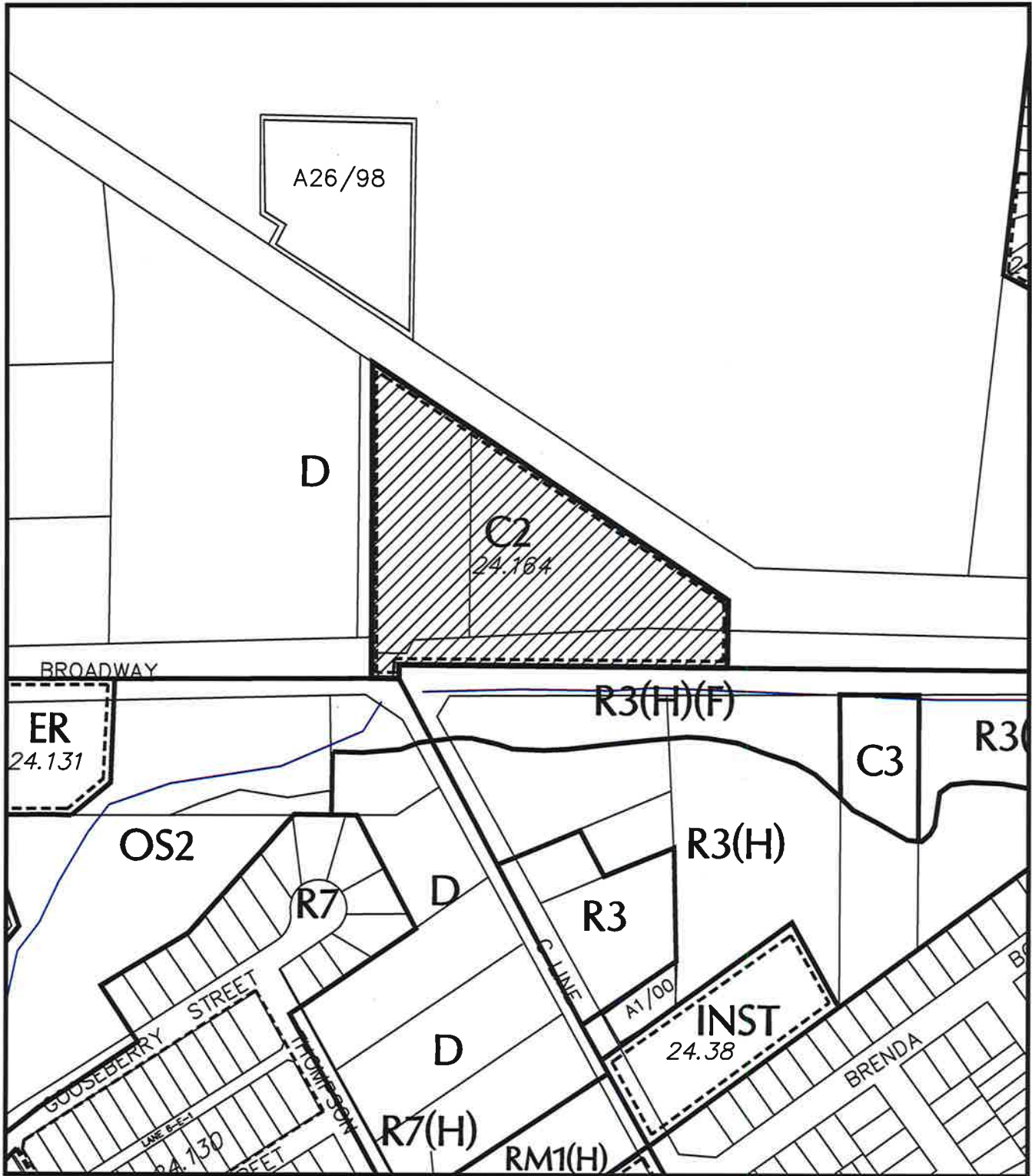
