

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF ORANGEVILLE

BY-LAW 95-93

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NUMBER 22-90

WHEREAS SECTION 39 OF THE PLANNING ACT R.S.O., CHAPTER P.13 AUTHORIZES THE MUNICIPALITY TO ENACT TEMPORARY USE BY-LAWS AND;

WHEREAS THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF ORANGEVILLE DEEMS IT APPROPRIATE TO ENACT THIS BY-LAW PURSUANT TO SECTION 39 OF THE PLANNING ACT R.S.O. 1990, CHAPTER P.13;

NOW THEREFORE THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF ORANGEVILLE BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL THEREOF ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 24, Special Provisions of By-law 22-90 is hereby amended by adding the following:

"24.75"

Notwithstanding the provisions of the "R4" Residential Fourth Density Zone, on lands described as Lot 115, Plan 314, a provincially-licensed, in-home daycare centre shall be permitted, as a temporary use, for a period of twenty-four (24) months after this By-law comes into effect, following which period of time, this By-law shall be deemed repealed.

2. For purposes of this By-law, the daycare centre shall be confined to utilize not more than 84 m² (900 square feet) of the residence at 356 Lisa Marie Drive, and shall accommodate not more than fifteen (15) children for daycare.
3. Schedule "A" to this By-law shall not form part of By-law 22-90 and is appended to this by-law for information purposes only.

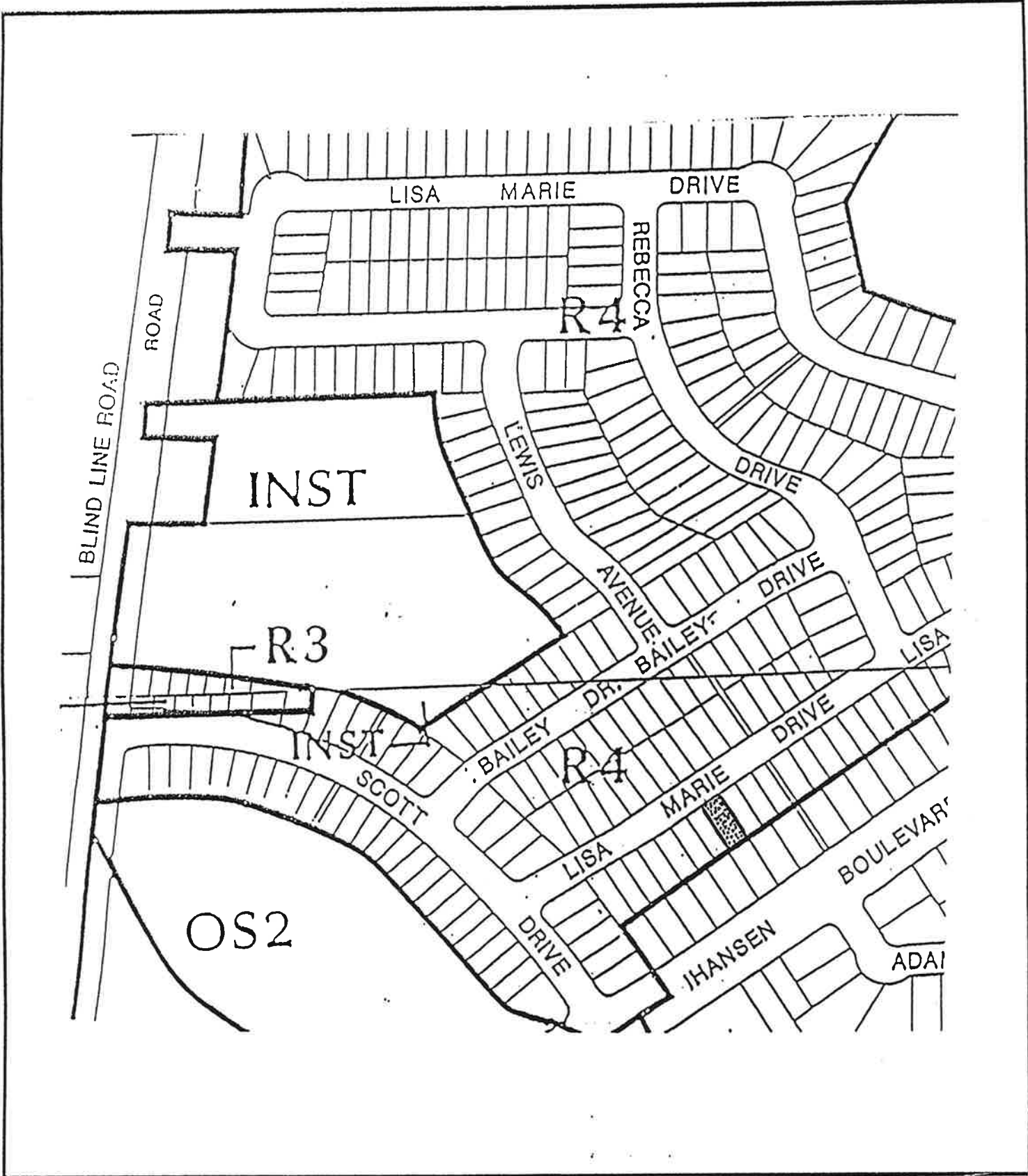
