BY-LAW 9-2011

**A BY-LAW TO AMEND TRAFFIC BY-LAW 78-2005 WITH
RESPECT TO PARKING RESTRICTIONS.
(Lane – north off Armstrong Street, east of Mill Street)**

WHEREAS the *Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, S.11* authorizes a municipality to pass by-laws respecting matters within the jurisdiction of highways, including parking and traffic on highways;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Orangeville deems it expedient to amend By-law No. 78-2005, as amended;

AND WHEREAS by resolution #6, passed on January 10, 2011, Council authorized a parking restriction in the lane that runs north off Armstrong Street, east of Mill Street, to the RBC parking area;

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the municipal council of the Corporation of the Town of Orangeville as follows:

1. THAT Schedule "A" (no parking where signs are posted) of By-law 78-2005, be amended to prohibit parking in the lane that runs north off Armstrong Street, east of Mill Street, to the RBC Bank parking area.
