BY-LAW NUMBER 18-2009

**A BY-LAW TO AMEND TRAFFIC BY-LAW
NO. 78-2005, AS AMENDED, TO PERMIT
THE PARKING OF SCHOOL BUSES IN
RESIDENTIAL AREAS.**

WHEREAS the *Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, S.11* authorizes a municipality to pass by-laws respecting matters within the jurisdiction of highways, including parking and traffic on highways;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Orangeville deems it expedient to amend Traffic By-Law No. 78-2005, as amended, to provide for the parking of school buses in residential areas;

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the municipal council of the Corporation of the Town of Orangeville as follows:

1. THAT Traffic By-law No. 78-2005, as amended, be further amended to delete Section 3.9 (parking vehicles) and replace it with the following wording;

“No person shall park or store a vehicle which is in excess of 7 metres in length or 3.5 metres high on a highway in a residential zone other than a school bus that is permitted to be parked from Monday to Friday between the hours of 9 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. for a maximum of three hour daily within the permitted times.”
